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Checklist for our hotel guests

- January 17th, 2022 -

1. What do I need for my overnight stay?

- The **2G+ - regulation** applies for hotel guests with overnight stay.

A stay is possible for fully **vaccinated persons** (basically two vaccinations and at least 14 days after the second vaccination) and for those who have **recovered**. In this case, it is sufficient to provide proof of vaccination by presenting a vaccination card or a vaccination certificate or proof of recovery with the presentation of an official photo ID. An official antigen test (not older than 24 hours) or PCR test (not older than 48 hours) must be carried out before arrival and the official test result must be presented on arrival.

The following groups of people are excluded from the regulation:

- Boosted people from the day of the booster vaccination
- Vaccinated people whose second vaccination was less than three months ago
- Recovered people whose corona infection was less than three months ago
- Persons who have been double vaccinated and recovered.

Here, the submission of the relevant certificate including official photo ID is required. These people do not need any further antigen test/PCR test.

An exception is the vaccination by Johnson & Johnson, which is also only considered "boosted" after two vaccinations and a booster vaccination with an mRNA vaccine.

With the 2G+ - regulation, residence is also possible for people who cannot be vaccinated for **medical reasons**.

This must be proven by a medical certificate. For this purpose, a **daily antigen** test is required for these persons within the meaning of Section 2 number 6 SchAusnahmV.

- Children under 7 years of age, as well as underage students who are regularly tested in school, are exempt from this rule. A one-time proof from the school that the students are regularly tested is sufficient. In the period of school holidays, this only applies in connection with an official test certificate, which is no more than 72 hours ago.

2. What should be considered before visiting our gastronomic areas?

In our Fischers Fritz restaurant

Daily 12:00 pm to 02:00 pm and 05:45 pm to 09:00 pm (until 08:30 pm you can order a 3-course menu, after this time it is just only one course possible). There is a curfew from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

In the **bar** daily 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. (the bar menu is valid)

- The **2G+ - regulation** applies to **all guests** when visiting our gastronomy (see above). Except for the groups of people mentioned under point 1.
Here, the presentation of a certificate is necessary incl. an ID. These persons do not need another antigen test/PCR test.
- This applies to **all gastronomic areas**: restaurant, bar, spa bistro, BBC foyer.
- All guests who are not in their permanent seat or standing area must wear a face-to-face mask (FFP2 or medical protective mask).
- A maximum of 10 people (children under the age of 14 are not counted) are allowed to sit at one table.
- In our restaurant, our air conditioning and an air purification device ensure sufficient air exchange.
- A table reservation is necessary in any case! This can be done by phone: 0431 5331-435 or at the hotel reception.

3. General information

If you have symptoms of illness that could indicate a possible corona infection, a stay with us is unfortunately no longer possible. You are obliged to inform us of this immediately.

- Please understand that our staff will greet you without physical contact.



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Our co-hosts

- In the hotel, the rules for co-hosts with guest contact are applied in the current state ordinance. Unvaccinated / unrecovered co-hosts must provide evidence of a test every 24 hours and are then also exempt from the mask requirement.
- Co-hosts must wear mouth and nose protection in closed rooms, unless they are in a permanent seat.

Minimum distance

- It is only recommended to keep a minimum distance of 1.5 m from one another.
- We also recommend that you only use the lifts with people traveling with you or that you take the stairs.

Mouth-nose-protection

- A qualified face mask (FFP2 or medical protective mask) must be worn in all interior areas of the hotel, unless the person is in a fixed place to sit, stand or lie down. This applies to all guests.

Hygiene & disinfection

- In all areas we regularly disinfect handrails, door handles, work surfaces, elevators, changing rooms, toilets etc.
- You will find disinfection dispensers in many public areas. Central areas in the hotel are disinfected several times a day.
- There is regular ventilation in all areas.

Public toilets

- For a safe stay and to minimize the risk of infection for guests and our team, please enter the public toilets on your own.

Reception

- It is recommended to keep a distance of 1.5 m.
- Plexiglass panes were attached to the reception desk for protection.
- Provide correct, complete contact details.
- Pay cashless if possible.
- Please understand that we prefer to send you the invoices by email. We would be happy to prepare your invoice the evening before your departure.

Rooms

- Due to the frequent feedback from guests and the saving of cleaning agents and resources, we have decided to offer daily **room cleaning on request**. Please let us know by 8:00 p.m. at reception if you would like a cleaning for the following day. A short refreshment of the room (towels if lying on the floor, garbage can and toilet consumables) continues to take place automatically every day.
- Please always ventilate your hotel room well after leaving.

Breakfast times

- Monday-Friday 6:30 – 10:00 am
Saturday-Sunday 7:00 – 10:30 am
- If you like to have a packed lunch box, we will be happy to provide you one. Please let the reception know by 08:00 pm the day before.
- We would like to point out that the period between 9:00 am and 10:00 am is a preferred time for breakfast, during which there may be waiting times.

Spa and wellness area

- The **2G+ - regulation** applies also to all hotel guests when visiting our wellness area and the spa bistro (see above). Except for the groups of people mentioned under point 1. Here, the presentation of a certificate is necessary incl. an ID. These persons do not need another antigen test/PCR test. Children are also excluded (see above).



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- A mouth and nose protection (FFP2 or medical protective mask) must be worn if the person is not in a fixed place to sit or lie down.
- Our treatment area for massages and cosmetic treatments is open.
- Daily from 10:00 am-07:00 pm.

- "Und GRETEL"- Make UP courses are not valid.
- Please let us know in advance whether you have any health restrictions or relevant peculiarities.
- **Our sauna area** is open Daily from 12:00 am - 10:00 pm.
- **The swimming pool and** is open Daily from 07:00 am - 8:00 pm.
- Our Spa Bistro is open daily from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
 - From 7:00 to 9:00 a.m. (Mon.-Fri.) **early swimming** is also available for our external guests.
 - The changing rooms and showers in the spa area are open.
 - Our experience has shown that there is an increased number of guests, especially in the evening and on weekends. We recommend that you inform yourself about the occupancy at our spa before your planned visit, so that you can relax without any inconvenience.
